100 days to convince. Elisabeth Borne will reveal in a few moments the government's roadmap for the coming months. Many projects are to come for the executive. During his televised speech on April 17th, Emmanuel Macron has also set the course for July 14 to make an initial assessment of the priority issues that will be announced by the Prime Minister.

As for Emmanuel Macron, he is today chairing the 6th National Conference on Disability, at the Elysée. This comes as France has just been sentenced by Europe for not respecting the rights of people with disabilities. The Handicaps collective has also announced that it is boycotting this national conference, deemed insufficient and not ambitious enough.

An investigation has been opened after the death of a 5-year-old girl in the Vosges. Her body was found yesterday afternoon in a garbage bag, in an apartment in Rambervilé. A 16-year-old boy who was in this apartment has been placed in police custody. He suffers from psychiatric disorders and was already known to the courts for sexual abuse of young children.

A first plane of French nationals evacuated from Sudan landed this morning at Roissy-Charles-de-Gaulle. On board, 245 people who fled the country where heavy fighting has been raging for almost 2 weeks.

And then a word of Handball: The French men's team faces Latvia tonight, as a qualification match for the 2024 Euro. But there's not too much pressure for Les Bleus, already qualified for the competition.
