The department of Eastern Pyrenees is facing an unprecedented drought. A drought committee is organized in this department which has not experienced heavy rains for almost a year - A committee with the Minister of Ecological Transition and Territorial Cohesion Christophe Béchu. The prefect has already warned this week that here will not be enough water for all uses this summer, in the department.

The Paris public prosecutor's office is appealing in the case of the Rio/Paris flight crash. The manufacturer Airbus and the company and airline Air France, prosecuted for involuntary homicides, were released on April 17 by the criminal court. This judgment had aroused "disgust" for the relatives of the victims. As a reminder, the crash had resulted in the death of 228 people in June 2009.

Two people died last night in the Parisian metro according to the RATP and the Fire Brigade. They were hit by a train at the station gaîté. According to the first elements, the victims were two homeless people – a man and a woman. They seemed drunk and supposedly argued on the platform. Both victims are said to have voluntarily gone down onto the tracks.

Justice is now accessible on your smartphone. The official website of the Ministry of Justice is available as a mobile application from today. The objective is "to simplify the lives of litigants to bring them closer to their justice" and to "facilitate access to rights".

And to finish: Will the Stade de France soon belong to the PSG ? The Parisian club has until noon to submit its bid for a takeover. The value of the stadium is estimated at more than 600 million euros. It will then be up to the State to decide.
