Today will see the end of a month of uncertainty for Go Sport as the Commercial Court in Grenoble will reveal who will be taking over the sports brand from a list of 20 candidates. It is likely to go to either Intersport France or the British brand, Frasers.

Hospital interns are on strike today, at their working conditions and to demand better pay, to the tune of 300 euros more per month. They are also demanding the postponement of the 10th year of study for future general practitioners.

In Paris, the line 6 of the metro is not running today as drivers have stood down. The union FO RATP has denounced a driver being taken into custody following a fatal accident on Saturday. A woman was killed after her jacket became stuck in the metro doors at Bel Air station.

The department of Pyrénées Orientales is braced for the announcement of a drought crisis this summer. Among the measures that are expected to be rolled out are the closure of car washes and watering restrictions for golf courses and farmers.

Two people have been killed in Dnipro in Ukraine in a fresh round of strikes from Russia. Three others lost their lives in Uman, a city of 80,000 inhabitants in the center of the country. Kiev was also targeted.

Finally, what path will the Olympic torch travel ahead of the Paris 2024 games? The Olympic torch relay route will be unveiled on June 23. The torch is expected to be passed across more than 60 French departments. As always, the torch will be lit in Olympia, Greece and will arrive in Marseille on May 9, 2024.
