We are a day away from the final of the French soccer cup, between Nantes and Toulouse. A final under close surveillance, with 3000 police and gendarmes mobilized for this event. And a final which Emmanuel Macron will attend according to his entourage. Those attending the match will have several means of making their dissatisfaction heard with several operations planned during the match.

The unions are planning a historic mobilization on May 1. Demonstrations promise to be a highlight of the protest against the pension reform. A vast security system will in any case be deployed: 12,000 police officers and gendarmes will be mobilized, including 5,000 in Paris.

As for Elisabeth Borne, she wishes a dialogue with the unions. The Prime Minister will send them an invitation sometime next week. Initially, each trade union organization will be invited individually before a large meeting.

In the rest of the news, Go Sport will soon be set on its fate. The Grenoble Commercial Court must reveal today the buyer of the sports brand placed in receivership since January - A choice to be made among around 20 candidates.

And a disturbing disappearance in Grenoble: The national police have launched a call for witnesses to find a young 22- year-old woman. This Italian national has not given any sign of life since last Saturday when she left her job.
