Vladimir Putin spoke before thousands of soldiers and officials this morning in Moscow. The Russian President spoke on this day of May 9, day of commemoration of the victory of the USSR over Nazi Germany. The opportunity for the head of the Kremlin to reaffirm his objectives regarding the conflict in Ukraine.
