Tax evasion in France represents each year 20 to 30 billion euros. An offense that the government wants to tackle. The Minister of Public Accounts Gabriel Attal announced today a series of measures to target in particular the ultra-rich and multinationals. A dedicated intelligence service will be created at Bercy and verifications will increase for large assets.

Gérald Darmanin asks the prefect to ban all new ultra-right demonstrations. This was announced by the Minister of the Interior at the National Assembly after the rally held on Saturday in Paris. Authorities have been criticized for not having banned this demonstration organized each year in tribute to a far-right activist killed in 1994.

He is the main suspect of the double murder that took place in Grasse last weekend. A 32-year-old man was taken into custody. Already known to the police, he was arrested at the wheel of the victims' stolen car. A couple in their eighties was found dead in their home on Saturday. The possibility of a burglary that went wrong is for the moment favored by investigators.

Abroad, Vladimir Putin spoke in front of thousands of soldiers and officials this morning. The Russian President spoke from Moscow on this day of May 9 - Date of commemoration of the victory of the USSR over Nazi Germany. This was an opportunity for the head of the Kremlin to evoke the war in Ukraine, accuse the West and promise a victory to his people.

Meanwhile, the President of the European Commission Ursula von der Leyen was in Kiev today, where She met with Volodymyr Zelensky. The Ukrainian President asked again for negotiations regarding the accession of his country to the EU.

And then a word of cycling, with a French victory in the Tour of Italy. Aurélien Paret-Peintre won the fourth stage of the Giro this evening. The Norwegian Andreas Leknessund - breakaway companion of the Frenchman takes the leader's pink jersey.
