This is the highest level of drought alert: A large part of the Pyrénées Orientales is placed in a crisis situation since yesterday. The rainfall deficit over the last 12 months amounts to more than 60%. A lack of water which is a very hard blow for farmers, and especially fruit growers.

The crisis level will remain in effect at least until June 13. It is accompanied by several restrictions such as the ban on watering private garden, filling swimming pools and even washing cars.

Monique Olivier may soon be judged. The Nanterre prosecutor's office is requesting a trial against the ex-wife of serial killer Michel Fourniret for complicity in the kidnapping of Estelle Mouzin, the murders of Marie- Angèle Domèce in 1988 and Joanna Parrish in 1990. Since the death of Michel Fourniret in 2021, Monique Olivier is the only person implicated in these three cases. It is now up to the investigating judge to decide whether these cases will go to trial or not.

"Securing access to the Internet" is the objective of a bill which was presented this morning in the Council of Ministers. It provides for measures to fight cyberbullying and establish scam filters.
