The unions in the national assembly: After Laurent Berger from the CFDT yesterday, it's the turn of Sophie Binet. The general secretary of the CGT was received today by the MPs of the Liot group. The pension reform that the group of independent elected representatives wishes to have revoked was at the heart of discussions. They have also submitted a bill to this effect that will be examined on June 8 in the Assembly. For Sophie Binet, the fight is far from over.

As for the government, it remains determined. The 31 implementing texts of the pension reform will be published before September 1 - date of its entry into force.

France is with Tunisia, says Emmanuel Macron after the deadly shooting near a synagogue yesterday on the island of Djerba. A gendarme killed 4 people before being shot dead by the police. A 42-year-old Frenchman is among the victims. A criminal investigation has been opened. For the moment, the terrorist nature of this attack is not being privileged.

And then in the United States, it's a 1st in 7 years: Donald Trump will be on CNN tonight. The declared candidate for the American presidential election will participate in a talk show. He will be surrounded by a public who will be able to ask him questions directly, including about his recent legal troubles. As a reminder, Donald Trump was sentenced yesterday for sexual assault. He will have to pay 5 million dollars to his victim.
