Another big project for the executive is the reindustrialization of the country. For this, Emmanuel Macron wants to work twice as hard. In the magazine "Challenges", the Head of State has already unveiled the main lines of his strategy: He wants to simplify procedures to halve the time needed to set up industries. The President will go to Dunkirk tomorrow to announce the construction of a new battery factory.

Elisabeth Borne is visiting the Reunion Island today. This will be a 3-day trip for the Prime Minister and her first trip to Overseas territories since she took office. She went first to St-Denis where she placed a wreath at the war memorial, before then going to Salazie to visit a hydraulic project. Several opponents of the pension reform planned saucepan concerts during her visits.

And the Prime Minister gave her full support this morning to Yannick Morez, the mayor of Saint-Brevin-les-Pins in Loire Atlantique, who decided to resign after being the target of several threats. The house of the elected official was even set on fire on March 22, after it was announced that a reception center for asylum seekers would be moved near a school. Following this, the city councilor announced his departure from the town hall, after 15 years of presence on the Municipal Council, including 6 years as mayor.

A 43-year-old woman was killed last night in a shooting in Marseille. According to investigators, she seems to have been a collateral victim. The shooting took place in the district of Saint-Joseph, near a place known for drug sales. An investigation has been opened.
