Three months after his last visit to France, Volodymyr Zelensky was back in Paris last night. The President of Ukraine is on a tour of Europe to secure more military aid. After a dinner between Zelensky and Emmanuel Macron last night at the Elysée, Paris announced that France will deliver dozens of armoured vehicles and light tanks to Kiev.

Emmanuel Macron will be making a television appearance tonight as the guest on channel TF1's 8pm news. The President will no doubt face questions on the war in Ukraine, as well as on his domestic policy. Macron has recently reiterated his priorities in an interview with *L'Opinion*. The President stressed that he wanted to continue lowering taxes for the middle classes, so that there was better pay for going to work.

Health workers who are not vaccinated against Covid 19 can now officially return to their jobs. The decree was published in the Journal Officiel yesterday, after it had been mandatory for health workers to be vaccinated since August 2021.

Turkey is headed for a second round in the presidential elections after outgoing President, Recep Erdogan did not achieve 50% of the votes in the first round. Erdogan took 49.35% of the vote, while his main opponent the social democrat Kemal Kilitch-Da-Rolou achieved 44.9%.

And finally, to football and Olympique Marseille have consolidated their place on the podium of Ligue 1. OM won 3-1 against Angers last night, at the end of day 35. Marseille are 3rd in the league 2 points behind Lens in second place.
