"Choose France" has begun. 200 big bosses of foreign multinationals are currently received at the Palace of Versailles by Emmanuel Macron. A 6th edition that should break records: The Elysée has already announced 13 billion euros of investments. For example, the global consulting firm Accenture will create in France a skills center dedicated to new generation networks and with this comes the creation of 500 jobs within 3 years.

After Rome, Berlin and Paris, Volodymyr Zelensky is today in London. A new stage of his European mini-tour to request additional military resources from Europe. The United Kingdom announced today the delivery of hundreds of anti-aircraft missiles and attack drones to Kiev. They will have no impact on the conflict, according to the Kremlin.

Who will be Turkey's next president? The final results of the 1st round are expected in the next few hours. The election is now between two men: On the one hand, outgoing President Recep Erdogan who yesterday did not obtain the 50% necessary for his re-election. On the other, his main opponent, the socialist democrat Kemal kiliçdaroglu.

Back in France, the main suspect in the Villerupt shooting in Meurthe et Moselle was arrested this morning. A man wearing a ski mask had opened fire Saturday evening near a drug trafficking point before fleeing. 5 people were injured, including 3 seriously.

In soccer, it's a relapse for Paul Pogba. The French midfielder of Juventus once again injured his left thigh last night in the Italian championship. He will be absent from the fields for two to three weeks. The 30-year-old should have recovered for the French team's gathering on June 9 in Clairefontaine. Les Bleus must prepare for the next two Euro 2024 qualifying matches.
