We know more about the tragedy that took place Monday evening at the Reims University Hospital. A nurse was fatally stabbed by a 59-year-old man who also injured a medical secretary. The suspect who was angry with the hospital staff had been receiving psychiatric treatment since 1985. He suffers from paranoia and schizophrenia. This was announced today by the public prosecutor of Reims during a press conference. The alleged murderer will be presented during the day to an examining magistrate with a view to his indictment for murder.

A man was shot and seriously injured in the middle of Paris this afternoon in the 8th arrondissement. The victim is a real estate agent in his 30s and he is currently in critical condition. The 2 shooters who were on motorcycles fled the scene and are wanted by the police.

Parties of the left, unions and associations are calling for a large rally in Saint-Brevin-les-Pins in Loire-Atlantique. The mobilization will begin in a few moments to support the resigning mayor of this town. Yannick Morez threw in the towel two weeks ago after pressure from the far right for having supported the installation of a refugee reception center in his city. His house and his car had even been set on fire last March.
