2 years after the sinking of a migrant boat in the English Channel which caused the death of 27 people, a dozen new people were taken into custody, among which soldiers from the Pas de Calais Surveillance and Rescue Center. In this case, the French authorities are suspected of having been called fifteen times on the night of the tragedy - without answering in time. The families of the victims are today asking for compensation for inaction.

Their names were Manon, Paul and Steven. The 3 police officers who died on Sunday in Villeneuve d'Ascq in a road accident caused by a driver who was drunk and tested positive for narcotics. A national tribute was paid to them today in Roubaix in the presence of Emmanuel Macron. The Head of State paid tribute to the memory of these 3 children of the Republic who had chosen to serve the nation. The President then posthumously decorated the 3 policemen with the Legion of Honor.

Will Creole become an official language in Martinique? The Assembly of Martinique must examine today a proposal aimed at giving Creole the status of co-official language of the department - in the same way as French. The Territorial Collectivity wishes in the long term to make compulsory the teaching of Creole in all schools on the island. This must first be validated by the State through a law.
