The general meeting of TotalEnergies ended calmly, despite the agitated morning. Environmental activists had gathered in front of the salle pleyel in Paris where the meeting between management and shareholder of the oil giant took place. They were mobilized to denounce the company's carbon footprint and clashes broke out with the police. At the end of the general meeting, Total's climate strategy was validated by the shareholders. It is worth noting that a resolution aimed at strengthening the actions of the group to reduce greenhouse gas emissions was rejected.

A victory for the families of victims of the Nice attack on July 14, 2016. 2,200 people have been recognized as civil parties by the special Circuit Court of Paris. Almost all the requests have been accepted. This decision paves the way for possible compensation, almost 7 years after the tragedy. The attack had caused 86 deaths on the *Promenade des Anglais*.

Still no trace of Eya. The 10-year-old girl was kidnapped yesterday by her father in front of her school in Fontaine in Isère. According to the Grenoble prosecutor's office, the man who has a dual Tunisian and Swedish nationality could have taken her abroad. the European police services and the magistrates concerned are mobilized.

France strongly condemns the Russian strikes which targeted Ukraine last night. 2 people died and around 20 others were injured in the bombing of a hospital.

And then a disappointment for the fans of Celine Dion: The Canadian singer is canceling all her concerts until April 2024 for health reasons. 6 dates were notably scheduled for September in France at La Défense Arena. "I'm sorry to disappoint you; I'm heartbroken" wrote the 55-year-old artist on her twitter account. She had revealed suffering from a rare neurological disorder last year and had already had to cancel her European tour scheduled for spring of 2023.
