A man is still in police custody in Morbihan, after being arrested last night. He is supposedly a friend of the young woman found in a river in Lanester near Lorient on Saturday morning. The 23-year-old victim was almost naked and bore traces of strangulation. She was completely unknown to the justice system, said the public prosecutor of Lorient. An investigation for intentional homicide is underway.

Achieving an agreement on plastic with 175 countries is the challenge of this summit which opens today in Paris at the UNESCO headquarters. This 2nd session of international discussions will last 5 days to try to reach a binding treaty on plastic pollution on the planet, while the production of plastic has doubled in 20 years throughout the world.

This is a direct consequence of the result of yesterday's elections: the Spanish Prime Minister has just announced early legislative elections for July 23. This comes following the heavy defeat of the Socialist Party in the local elections, with the loss of 6 regions out of 10 going to the Popular Party, the right-wing opposition party as well as several large cities, such as Valence and Seville.

Following the first round at Roland Garros, Benoît Pair is on the courts right now. The Frenchman got a wild card to join the final table directly. He faces the British Cameron Norrie, number 14 on the Suzanne Lenglen court. The French Christina Mladenovic also begins her tournament against the American Day, following the qualifications. This afternoon Caroline Garcia and Arthur Fils will be playing but also worth noting is the entry into the running of 2 big favourites: Carlos Alcaraz and Novak Djokovic.

And then there will be traffic on the roads again this afternoon on this last day of the long weekend. It's Orange for returns on the entire northwest quarter. And traffic on the A7 going up towards Lyon will be very heavy in the Rhône Valley. Traffic will also be heavy in the Paris region the evening.
