The pension reform is once again discussed in the National Assembly with rather tense exchanges this afternoon. Elisabeth Borne notably raised her voice against the bill proposed by the group Liot, which wants to return to a retirement at 64. The Prime minister speaks of an unconstitutional text; but it will however be discussed tomorrow in committee at the assembly after the green light from Eric Coquerel - the chairman of the finance committee. The majority now wants to avoid at all costs that it be debated in the Assembly on June 8th.

Billy Berclau's giant battery factory for electric cars in the Pas de Calais region was spectacularly inaugurated this morning. The first French gigafactory is due to start production in the summer. The objective is to equip 500,000 cars by 2030.

Could Yvan Colonna's fatal attack in the prison of Arles in March 2022 have been avoided? This is the question that a parliamentary commission of inquiry tried to answer in a report which was published today. As a reminder, the Corsican independence activist was attacked by another detainee before dying a few days later as a consequence of his injuries. After more than 6 months of work and 70 hearings, the report pointed to a series of failures, inactions and errors on the part of the prison authorities.

18 months in prison were requested against the rugby player Mohamed Haouas. The player of Montpellier and the XV of France was tried today in immediate appearance for domestic violence. He is accused of having hit his wife Friday in a mall of Montpellier in front of many witnesses.

Abroad, Russia denounces a terrorist act after the drone attack carried out this morning by Kiev on Moscow in which 2 people were injured. For the Kremlin, this is a response of Ukrainian power after the Russian strikes that hit Kiev yesterday.

And then tennis at Roland Garros with the qualifications for the 2nd round of the Frenchwomen Diane Parry and Océane Dodin. It's over on the other hand for Fiona Ferro. In the men's draw, Hugo Gaston is also eliminated. This evening, Richard Gasquet and Gael Monfils will enter the competition.
