Four complaints were filed by Lindsay's family. These complaints were filed against the director of the school, the academy of Lille, the police, and against the social network Facebook after the death of the 13-year-old teenager. The schoolgirl, victim of harassment, decided to end her life on May 12 in Vendin le Vieil in Pas de Calais. At a press conference this morning, Lindsay's mother and stepfather believe that they have received no support from the state services. They had however issued several reports in recent months.

Four minors were also indicted in this case for school bullying leading to suicide.

Strong emotions also today in Reims. The funeral of Carène Mézino was held this morning in the Saint-Rémi basilica. The 37-year-old nurse was fatally stabbed last week at the city's university hospital. The relatives, but also hospital staff, dressed in white coats, participated in the ceremony. As for the investigation, the suspect with a heavy psychiatric history was indicted and placed in pre-trial detention.
