72,000 hectares of vegetation were destroyed in 2022 as a result of last summer's fires. To try to avoid a new summer season under the flames, Emmanuel Macron is presenting this afternoon the new tool for Météo France from the department of Gard, called "Forest weather". The objective is to inform the population "of the level of fire danger in mainland France" and encourage them to adopt the right actions. This measure will also be helpful for professionals already mobilized throughout the year.

The forest weather forecast communicates on the risk of fire on a scale of four colors ranging from low to very high - Green being low risk and red, very high.

In the rest of the news, there will indeed be a technical inspection for two-wheelers in France. The Council of State now gives the government two months to put it in place. The terms and the timetable will be specified in the coming days by the Minister Transport Clément Beaune.

Abroad, the United States avoids bankruptcy. The country postpones the threat of a payment default to 2025. After the House of Representatives, the Senate agrees to provisionally suspend the debt limit. The text was the subject of long negotiations between President Joe Biden and the Republican party.

And then tennis at Roland Garros, with the beginning of the 3rd round. This afternoon the world number 1 player Carlos Alcaraz and Serbian Novak Djokovic will be playing. As a reminder, there are already no more of French players in the tournament; they were all eliminated.
