Almost 6 months after the suicide of the young Lucas in the Vosges, 4 teenagers have been found guilty of harassment against the 13-year-old schoolboy. The decision was communicated this morning by the children's court of Epinal. However, the judges did not retain a causal link between these events and the teenager's suicide.

These 4 minors risk up to 18 months in prison. The next hearing will decide on their sanctions and will take place on January 22, 2024.

Also in the news, reinforced security tomorrow on the sidelines of the 14th day of mobilization against pension reform. 11,000 police and gendarmes will be deployed throughout France. 4,000 in Paris alone. We expect between 400,000 and 600,000 demonstrators, but also ultra-left groups from abroad. SNCF traffic should not be too disrupted tomorrow, with 9 out of 10 trains in circulation on average. On the other hand, in the air, 20% of flights should be canceled at most airports and even one third at the airport of Paris-Orly.

The Disciplinary Committee of the soccer League will make its decision next Monday. It met this afternoon after the incident which took place on Friday evening during the last day of Ligue 2 between Bordeaux and Rodez, during which a supporter of Bordeaux entered the field and shoved a Ruthenian player. The match was definitively stopped.
