"The pension reform will not be revoked", said Yaël Braun Pivet this morning on BFM TV. The President of the National Assembly assures that she will declare inadmissible any amendment aimed at restoring article 1 of the bill of the Liot group which will be examined tomorrow by the MPs - The article that provides for a return to retirement at 62.

As for the president of the group "La France Insoumise" in the Assembly, Mathilde Panot, she submitted a motion of censure this morning against the government.

The bill for full employment was presented this morning in the Council of Ministers. At the heart of the text is the transformation of Pôle emploi into "France Travail" - A new body that will allow better and more personalized support to facilitate the search for work. The objective is to bring the country towards full employment within 4 years.

And Pope Francis will have an emergency operation this afternoon in Rome. The 86-year-old sovereign pontiff will undergo surgery, under general anesthesia, for a risk of intestinal obstruction. An operation necessary after an aggravation of symptoms according to the medical team.
