The pension reform will again be at the heart of the debates tomorrow in the Assembly. The MPs will examine from 9 a.m. the bill proposed by the group Liot to revoke the text. But it is a text emptied of its substance: The first article, which wants to bring the retirement age back to 62, was rejected last week by the Assembly's social affairs committee. Yaël Braun Pivet, the President of the National Assembly assured this morning that she will declare inadmissible any amendment to restore this article. A worrying decision on the ability of parliamentarians to carry out their mission according to the Liot MP of the North Benjamin Saint-Huile and many others.

Also in the news: Abroad, Vladimir Putin denounces a barbaric act by Kiev after the destruction of a hydroelectric dam in southern Ukraine. The Russian president accuses Ukrainian forces of being behind the disaster to stop the offensives. The river has already flooded a hundred localities in the region of Kherson. More than 2700 people have already been evacuated.

The ANSM alerts on the misuse of medication. The National Medicines Safety Agency launched today a vast campaign to encourage the French to make better use of pharmaceutical products. In our country, 1 in 5 people takes higher doses or several drugs at the same time to relieve symptoms more quickly. The institution also denounces self-medication or the use of expired medication by patients.

And to finish, Mohamed Haouas will not participate in the Rugby World Cup. This was confirmed today by Fabien Galthié. As expected, the coach of the XV of France, will not select the right pillar, following his conviction for domestic violence.
