There was a knife attack against children in Haute Savoie. It happened this morning in a park near Lake Annecy. At least 7 people including 6 young children were injured. We do not have more information on the incident for the time being.

And following this tragedy, Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne changed her schedule to be present in Annecy.

The kidnapping alert is still active in France to try to find Malek. The 8-year-old girl who was allegedly kidnapped by her father in Dunkirk. They have not been seen for more than 24 hours. The fugitive's partner was found dead in her home. The police had intervened a few hours earlier for an argument and the victim had filed two complaints for domestic violence.
