Silvio Berlusconi has died at the age of 86. The information was communicated by the Italian press agency ANSA. The former President of the Italian Council had marked the politics of his country for more than two decades. He had exercised power three times, in 1994, between 2001 and 2006 and between 2008 and 2011. He had also returned to the benches of the Senate since 2022 after the victory of the right in the parliamentary elections.

The National Assembly is at the heart of political news today. The Mps are examining the Valletoux bill concerning the fight against medical deserts. The objective is to improve access to care for patients with a text aiming at better regulating the installation of doctors in the territory. However, the text is not popular among liberal doctors. The doctors' unions are calling for a strike on July 4th. They denounce a situation that has never been so critical in public hospitals.

Another event this afternoon in the Assembly is the debates concerning the motion of censure of the NUPES against the government. The last one filed by the LIOT group on March 20 had failed but this time the context is different, as the LR group will not vote for it - The LIOT group did not give any voting instructions.

Also in the news, Ukraine claims the recovery of a village in the South West of the country. A first step in the Ukrainian counter offensive announced since Saturday by President Volodymyr Zelensky at a press conference. The counter offensive concerns three localities in the region of Donetsk.

And Donald Trump announces that he will speak tomorrow after his court appearance. The former US President is the subject of 37 charges for having taken with him confidential documents after leaving power. He is to be heard tomorrow in Miami and will speak from New Jersey at 8:15 p.m. local time.
