The Italian government declares a National Day of Mourning on Wednesday, after the death of Silvio Berlusconi. The former Italian prime minister and businessman died today at the age of 86 from leukemia. The funeral will be organized on Wednesday in Milan.

Authorized for sale for a long time in France, HHC - the synthetic derivative of cannabis, is now considered a narcotic. The National Medicines Safety Agency considers that it presents a risk of abuse and dependence. As of tomorrow, the consumption and sale of HHC will be prohibited, as announced this afternoon by the Minister of Health François Braun.

The motion of censure of the NUPES to bring down the government is currently being debated in the National Assembly. It was submitted last week by the *Insoumis* MPs after the failure of the revocation of the pension reform.

3 weeks after the death of Iris, the 23-year-old girl was found in a river in Lanester. The prosecutor of Lorient gave this afternoon more information on the details of the murder. The autopsy of the victim revealed traumatic sexual injuries. In this case, a 49-year-old man was indicted for the rape and murder of the young woman.

2 20-year-old men were placed in police custody today in Ajaccio after the attack on the young Kenzo. This young OM supporter, only 8 years old and suffering from brain cancer, was violently taken to task on June 3 in Ajaccio by Corsican supporters on the sidelines of the soccer match between Ajaccio and Marseille. The 2 suspects turned themselves in to the police.

And then in soccer, the LFP disciplinary committee has delivered its verdict: it will be a lost match for Bordeaux. The Girondins are sanctioned after the incident during the Second league Bordeaux-Rodez match between a supporter and a Ruthenian player. Bordeaux therefore remains in second league. This decision also marks the rise of FC Metz in Premier Ligue and the relegation of Annecy to Nationals.
