A relocation of the production of medications in France, is what Emmanuel Macron is expected to announce today from Ardèche, as shortages have been increasing over the past ten years due to dependence on foreign producers. The Observatory of transparency in drug policies is however awaiting clarification.

Otmeds also calls for transparency on public aid granted to private pharmaceutical manufacturers.

Searches are in progress at the home of journalist Mohamed Sifaoui. The Senate's commission of inquiry announced this morning that it would hear him today as part of the investigation into the embezzlement of public funds related to the "Marianne Fund", an association which fights separatism. He is questioned on the use of a subsidy of 355,000 €. A search is also underway at the home of the prefect Christian Gravel, the former manager of the Marianne Fund.

Abroad, a tragedy took place in Nottingham, UK, where three people were found dead in the streets of the city. We do not have further information for the time being. A 31-year-old man was arrested. The city center was cordoned off by the police.

And then in soccer: the Spanish press is enthusiastic after the announcement of Kylian Mbappé. The striker told the PSG that he would not exercise the option on his last year of contract. As a result, the capital club could sell the world champion this summer. The rumor of an arrival at Real Madrid, therefore resurfaces in Spain.
