More than 2 months after the disappearance of Karine Esquivillon in Vendée, her husband was placed in police custody this morning. The investigation, initially opened for "kidnapping and forcible confinement", is now one for murder. Since the start of the investigation, the gendarmes have noticed several inconsistencies in the husband's story. He had, for example, waited 1 week before reporting the disappearance of his wife.

6 months in prison with a 2-year probationary suspended sentence were requested against Jean Marc Morandini. The host of Cnews has been on trial since yesterday for the sexual harassment of a young actor and for the concealed work of 5 people in his production company. 6 months ago, Jean-Marc Morandini was already given a 1-year suspended prison sentence for "corruption of minors".

She defended herself for almost 3 hours. Marlène Schiappa was heard today by the Senate inquiry committee. The Secretary of State for the Social and Solidarity Economy had to explain herself about her management of the Marianne Fund – a fund set up after the assassination of Samuel Paty to fight separatism. She denied having intervened in the allocation of subsidies.

The project for a reception site for homeless Parisians is abandoned in Bruz, Brittany. It confirms, however, the opening of a temporary site in Montgermont from next week.
