Supporting "rural renewal" is the objective of the government which today presented its France rurality plan. From Vienne, Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne announced the creation of an engineering program called "Villages of the future". It should provide logistical support from the State for municipal projects - A very promising system according to Yvan Lubraneski, vice-president of the association of rural mayors.

Among the other measures announced is the deployment of 100 medical buses to improve access to care.

The prefecture of Savoy has just announced this afternoon the ban on all gatherings this weekend, as a major demonstration was planned for Saturday on the construction site of the Lyon -Turin line, at the initiative of the group of opponents "Soulèvements de la Terre". The prefecture underlines the risks of misbehaviors and incidents.

Several NGOs and associations are asking for more resources for rescue at sea. They denounce the responsibility of the European Union in the sinking of a boat of 750 migrants yesterday in Greece where at least 78 people died. It is one of the worst humanitarian disasters in the Mediterranean. A 3-day national mourning has been decreed in the country.
