Tragic ending in Vendée after the disappearance of Karine Esquivillon. Her body was found in the woods last night after the confession of her husband. He confessed while in police custody nearly 3 months after the disappearance of his wife. He says her death was the result of an accident as he was cleaning his firearm.

Michel Piale is presented at this very moment to an examining magistrate, and is expected to be indicted.

In the rest of the news, the company Philips is in trouble. The company is the target of more than 200 complaints of deception, endangering the lives of others and administering harmful substances. The giant of electronics is accused of having marketed respirators with a component suspected of being carcinogenic. It was then slow to withdraw these respirators from the market.

The objective of Emmanuel Macron is to make France the leading country in ultra-clean aircraft. During a visit this morning to the Safran group in Villaroche in Seine-et-Marne, the head of State announced several measures to achieve this objective. Among these measures, is an investment of 300 million euros per year over the period of 2024 to 2030 to support the aeronautics sector in decarbonization.
