15 departments are still placed under orange weather alert for thunderstorms: from Charente maritime to the Marne. Météo France calls for the greatest caution after yesterday's bad weather which affected a good part of the country, causing flooding, disruptions for trains and even power cuts.

After 4 years of absence, the biggest aeronautical meeting in the world is back. The 54th Paris Air Show is taking place until Sunday. Emmanuel Macron arrived this morning on site. The Head of State is there to support an entire sector in full recovery after the COVID pandemic, with an objective: that of decarbonizing aviation. He has already promised 300 million euros in aid per year over the period of 2024 to 2030.

4 men of the neo-Nazi movement are tried from today at the court for minors in Paris. They are suspected of criminal terrorist projects between 2017 and 2018. They wanted to commit an attack at a dinner of the CRIF, against the rapper Médine or even at a meeting of Jean-Luc Mélenchon. This is the first trial at the court for ultra-right terrorism. It will last until June 30.

And the SNCF is also in court today. The railway company is on trial before the Paris police court following the complaint filed by the foundation 30 Million d'Amis. It is accused of having caused the death of a cat last January. The animal had been run over by a train at the Montparnasse station. Its owner is now asking the company for an explanation. If the events are considered a voluntary act, the SNCF could be fined 7500 euros.

How can the government save billions of euros? It is launching today its public finance meeting. The executive will reveal the details of the budget cuts planned to redress France's accounts and accelerate its debt reduction. The State wishes to save money after pouring billions of euros to help households and businesses in the face of the covid health crisis and then with inflation.
