The dissolution of the collective "Soulèvements de la Terre" will be presented tomorrow in the Council of Ministers. This was confirmation this evening by Gérald Darmanin. The Minister of the Interior accuses these radical environmental activists of being at the origin of several violent actions, including those against the construction of mega-basins. The rally organized in March in Sainte Soline had degenerated; several members of the police had been injured during clashes. As for the collective, it denounces a very political and disturbing decision.

Also in the news, the race against time in the North Atlantic: Research is still underway to try to find a small tourist submarine. Titan has been missing since Sunday evening when it had left to explore the wreck of the Titanic with five passengers on board. Among them was the French former naval officer Paul-Henri Nargeolet. France will also send a ship equipped with a robot to support in-depth research.

A face to face to ease tensions. Italian Prime Minister Giorgia Meloni is received this evening at the Elysée by Emmanuel Macron. For several months, the question of immigration has soured relations between Paris and Rome. At the beginning of May, Gérald Darmanin had even directly attacked Giorgia Meloni, unable, according to him, to solve the problem of illegal immigration. Remarks which had almost created a diplomatic incident.

In Ukraine, a rescue worker was killed, and eight others injured in a Russian strike in Kherson, in the south of the country. Rescuers were mobilized on site after the destruction of a dam in early June, which had caused heavy flooding in the region.

In Rugby, will Antoine Dupont be at the Paris 2024 Olympics? The captain of the *XV de France* dreams of participating in the event. He will have to join the Rugby 7s team and give up the 6 nations tournament next February with *Les Bleus*. The subject will be at the heart of a meeting tomorrow within the authorities of French rugby.

And then watch out for thunderstorms. 17 departments in the southwest and center are under storm alert. The alert runs from the Atlantic Pyrenees to the Loire via the Haute Garonne. Météo France calls for caution in the face of a risk of heavy rain and hail.
