The 5 passengers of the Titan died after the implosion of the submarine. This is the scenario put forward by the American coast guards during a press conference last night. Debris from the machine was discovered in the ocean and the US Navy also claims to have picked up the signal of an implosion on Sunday. Research will continue on site to try to understand how such a tragedy could have happened, but there is very little chance that the bodies will be found.

The center of the phenomenon is evacuating into the Caribbean Sea, but Martinique remains under red alert due to the passage of storm Bret. Schools will remain closed today as strong gusts of wind hit the island overnight. Nearly 20,000 homes were without power last night.

There was a vast action against scams for false court summons for child pornography. After 2 years of investigation, 19 people were arrested in France and Belgium. The suspected criminals pretended to be police officers and then sent messages to hundreds of recipients asking them to pay a fine to avoid legal proceedings. More than 300 complaints had been filed for a total damage estimated at more than three million euros.

Also in the news, twitter will have to strengthen its procedures by the end of August in order to comply with the new European legislation. This is the warning issued by Thierry Breton after his meeting with Elon Musk. "If the technology is not ready, they must be able to fill the gap" indicates the European commissioner. He is currently visiting the United States to ensure that the web giants are ready to comply with the law which will come into force in two months.

And then what route for the Olympic flame? One year from the Paris Olympics, the organizers will reveal at midday the departments that will be crossed. Nearly 10,000 people will take turns for more than 2 months, we already know that the flame will begin its journey on May 8 in Marseille and will arrive in Paris on July 26.
