To fight educational inequality, Emmanuel Macron announced from Marseille that middle schools will gradually be open from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. in priority neighborhoods. Kindergartens will also be accessible there from the age of 2. The head of the State continues his visit of Marseille today. He was this morning in an elementary school that is being renovated thanks to his "Marseille en grand" project launched 2 years ago.

A man was shot and killed by the police this morning in Nanterre. The officer allegedly opened fire on the driver who supposedly ran over him after refusing to comply. One of the passengers, who is said to be a minor, was arrested, and a second passenger has fled.

Health Insurance will cut up to 1,700 jobs by 2027, but under certain conditions. The job cuts will be subject to productivity gains and with a review clause in 2 years.

3 days after the attempted rebellion of the Wagner group against Moscow, Russian authorities have finally decided to drop their charges against the members of this militia. They believe that the participants in the mutiny have put an end to their actions aimed directly at committing a crime, say security services. The Russian Ministry of Defense has announced that preparations are underway to transfer heavy military equipment from Wagner to units of the Russian Armed Forces.

And Donald Trump is once again facing trouble: The media CNN has published a recording dating from 2021 where the former President of the United States claims to have confidential documents from the Pentagon. As a reminder, Donald Trump is being prosecuted by the American justice system for his neglectful management of confidential documents after leaving the White House.

And to finish, visitors can catch a glimpse of the intimacy of Marie-Antoinette. Versailles opens from today to the public the apartments of the former Queen of France, which have just been renovated. It will therefore be possible to visit her private spaces which are spread over 2 floors. For two weeks, guided tours of this part of the castle will be offered.
