The investigation is only beginning after the death of Nael yesterday in Nanterre. The 17-year-old was killed during a traffic check after a police officer opened fire. The officer is in custody for intentional homicide and his custody was extended this evening. He explained that the young man had ran into him with his car, however a video filmed by a witness seems to prove otherwise.

Since this tragedy, many have reacted, including politicians. "Nothing justifies the death of a young person" declared Emmanuel Macron who spoke of inexplicable and inexcusable events. For Prime Minister Elisabeth Borne, "The truth must be revealed as soon as possible".

In addition, a solemn march will be organized tomorrow at 2 p.m. in Nanterre by the family of Nael. The mayor of the city who demands justice also calls for calm to avoid new misbehaviors after those of last night.

In the rest of the news, a sentence of life imprisonment with a 22-year security sentence was requested against Gabriel Fortin, also nicknamed the HRD killer. He has been on trial since June 13 before the circuit court of Drôme for 3 murders and an attempted murder in 2021. The verdict is expected in the evening.
