Hundreds of people gathered in support of the mayor of L'Haÿ-les-Roses. They are currently marching through the streets of the city of Val de Marne, with Vincent Jeanbrun at the head of the procession, whose home was targeted this weekend. Also present alongside the elected official, is the President of the Senate Gérard Larcher, the MP and president of the LR Eric Ciotti and the president of the group Renaissance in the National Assembly Aurore Bergé.. Gatherings were also organized this afternoon in front of all the town halls of France as a sign of solidarity.

In Marseille, an emergency fund was released for businesses that have been vandalized these past days. At the initiative of Région Sud and the Aix-Marseille metropolis, the measure will provide 10,000 euros, without conditions and paid within 15 days at the most.

Regarding the investigation opened for intentional homicide after the death of Nahel in Nanterre, the 3<sup>rd</sup> passenger present in the car at the time of the events went to the police station today. He is currently heard by the IGPN to deliver his version of the events.

In the rest of the news, court clerks are on strike today with demonstrations in courts throughout the country to denounce their new salary scale and demand more human resources. This social movement takes place as the Keeper of the Seals Eric Dupont Moretti presents his justice programming bill today to the National Assembly.

The RTE network manager speaks of a technical incident. A major power cut deprived a large part of western Paris of power this morning. In total, more than 160,000 households were affected in the capital and several municipalities of Hauts-de-Seine. Everything was back to normal at the end of the morning. RTE specifies that this breakdown has no connection with the riots and violence committed these past days".

And then rugby: Things are getting serious for the XV de France. The 42 players selected to prepare for the World Cup in France begin their first training camp. The group of Fabien Galthié is in Monaco until the 14<sup>th</sup> of July. The French champions Antoine Dupont, Romain Ntamack and Thomas Ramos are present.
