The circulation of buses and trams will resume normally throughout France this evening. This was announced by the Minister Delegate for Transport, Clément Beaune. The decision was made as tensions begin to subside after several nights of riots linked to the death of Nahel. Only 16 people were arrested last night, which is the lowest number of arrests in a week. Minister of the Interior Gérald Darmanin will be heard this afternoon by the Senate Law Commission.

Nine people are indicted in relation to the fire at the town hall of Mons-en-Barœul, in the area of Lille. Three agents were still in the town hall, and were, in the end, able to be evacuated. The nine indicted are prosecuted for "willful violence against persons holding public authority".

And this urban violence has severely penalized some businesses. To support them, the sales are extended for a week, until August 1. A measure taken "at the request of business owners", according to the Minister for SMEs Olivia Grégoire. In addition, all business owners will be able to open their store exceptionally this Sunday.

Pierre Palmade is back in hospital. The comedian, indicted after his serious road accident in early February, returned to the addiction service of the Pellegrin hospital in Bordeaux a few days ago, at his own request. At the end of June Pierre Palmade was seen in a nightclub - An outing authorized by his judicial control.

And the Tour de France with the fifth stage this afternoon. The first in the mountains, in the Pyrenees and an opportunity for the favorites for the final victory to know where they stand. This stage is made up of 162 km between Pau and Larunse. Adam Yates still has the Yellow Jersey after 4 stages.

And then in soccer, a page is turning at PSG. After the departure of Christophe Galtier, the club's new coach, Luis Enrique, was just introduced. The Spaniard's club was eliminated in the round of sixteen at World Cup with Spain. In his career Luis Enrique notably won the Champions League with Barcelona.
