Preventing and fighting violence against elected officials is the objective of the plan announced today by Dominique Faure, the Minister Delegate in charge of Local Authorities. This system complements the measures taken mid-May after the resignation of the mayor of Saint Brévin les Pins, Yannick Morèze, whose home had been set on fire. A few days after the riots, the executive intends to establish better legal, physical, psychological and judicial protection - A reinforcement welcomed by Murielle Fabre, Secretary General of the Association of Mayors of France.

Currently, the legal protection of mayors must systematically go through a deliberation of the municipal council. This national plan will make it automatic.

Two weeks after the explosion rue Saint-Jacques in Paris, a passer-by died in the hospital as a result of her injuries. She was walking by the building at the time of the tragedy. The explosion had already made a first victim, found several days later in the rubble.

The lawyer for the police officer who shot Nahel files a complaint. Maître Laurent-Franck Liénard denounces death threats made against him. The police officer in question has been indicted for intentional homicide and is imprisoned at the *prison de la santé*.

Jasper Philipsen wins the seventh stage of the Tour de France in Bordeaux in a sprint. It is his third stage victory on this great loop. Dane Jonas Vingegaard keeps the yellow jersey.

And then beware, 10 departments in the south-west are under orange alert for thunderstorms: From the Pyrénées-Atlantiques to Dordogne via Haute-Garonne. These storms are expected this evening, with a risk of hail and strong gusts of wind.
