Emmanuel Macron will not speak on July 14 but in the coming days, says the Elysée. However, it was the president himself who announced "an assessment" of the "100 days of appeasement" on the national holiday. Since his arrival at the Elysée, Emmanuel Macron has only spoken twice on the occasion of July 14.

The government is increasing the budget for *Ma Prime Renov* by 66% next year. This is the flagship measure for aid in the renovation of housing. It will be increased from 2.4 to 4 billion euros. This was announced by the executive during a National Council for Ecological Transition in Paris. Elisabeth Borne added that an additional 264 million euros will be devoted to biodiversity in 2024.

New areas were searched today by the gendarmes in the area where Emile disappeared. The two-and-a-half-year-old child had wandered off from his grandparents' home on Saturday in Vernet in the Alpes de Haute Provence. The public prosecutor said last night that so far, the investigators had no clue to explain this disappearance.

And the strike is renewed for the editorial staff of the Sunday newspaper to protest the arrival at its head of Geoffroy Lejeune, ex-director of Valeurs Actuelles. The editorial board is conducting its twentieth day of strike and the continuation of the movement was voted with 94% of votes.

Today is the last day of the NATO summit in Lithuania. Westerners must present a plan of long-term commitments for Ukraine and the Ukrainian president is meeting with the main leaders of the alliance. The US State Department spokesman said that Ukraine will become a member of NATO regardless of Russia's position.

The writer Milan Kunder - a monument of literature - has died at the age of 94. A former communist of Czech origin, he went into exile in France in the mid-1970s before the release of his bestseller *The Unbearable Lightness of Being*, in 1984. His world-famous work has been translated into 80 languages.

And to finish, many people are expected on the roads this weekend of July 14. The day of Saturday is classified as red for departures throughout the territory. It is recommended to leave big cities before 6am.
