It is absolutely forbidden to throw cigarette butts in nature, to carry out construction work near wooded areas or to light a fire in the forest. The risk of fire is very high today in the Bouches du Rhône. The department has been placed under red alert by Météo France, for the first time since the launch of the Forest Weather system last June. The alert is accompanied by a reinforcement of the firefighters' workforce.

Regarding the neighboring departments, the risk of fire is high in the Vaucluse and the Var, which have been placed under orange alert by Météo France.

Also in the news, 2 men were shot dead in Evreux and a 3rd person is seriously injured and hospitalized after a shooting broke out last night in the sensitive district of Madeleine. The 2 victims, aged 34 and 39, were shot while they were in a car. The perpetrator is wanted, and an investigation has been opened.

Despite the strike of the journalists of the Journal du Dimanche, Geoffroy Lejeune will indeed be at the head of the editorial staff of the weekly newspaper. The former director of *Valeurs Actuelles*, from the far right, will take office on August 1. His nomination had resulted in the strike of the employees, which lasted more than a month.
