Éric Dupond-Moretti will appear before the Court for illegal conflict of interest. He is suspected of having taken advantage of his function as minister to settle scores with magistrates. Éric Dupond-Moretti says he is waiting "with confidence" for his trial.

Two people are dead and at least five injured in critical condition as a result of this tragic road accident this morning in the Yvelines between a bus and a car. The bus swerved to avoid the car which was arriving in the wrong direction. The victims are the passengers of the bus. The 21-year-old driver of the car, seriously injured, was arrested, his blood alcohol level is being checked. Transport Minister Clément Beaune calls for everyone's responsibility during this very busy weekend on the roads.

The presidential campaign of Valérie Pécresse is targeted by a second investigation. A preliminary investigation, relating to suspicions of abuse of social goods has been opened. At the heart of the investigations are the rental conditions of one of the two campaign headquarters of the candidate of *les Républicains*. Last September, the Paris prosecutor's office had already opened a preliminary investigation for embezzlement of public funds.

And for the sixth time in a row, the Journal du Dimanche will not be published this weekend. The editorial staff, still opposed to the arrival at its head of Geoffroy Lejeune, renewed its strike. It has been going on for now more than a month. A delegation of journalists was received this morning by the office of the Minister of Culture. They want the law to change to guarantee the editorial independence of editorial staff.
