An 18-year-old male has been charged with the rape and torture of a young woman in Cherbourg. He is also the subject of another ongoing investigation for sexual assault on his sister. The prosecution has indicated that while he was a minor, he was sentenced five times by a juvenile court.

At the traditional festival, the Feria in Dax, an 18-year-old male has been seriously injured after falling from a second-floor window. He was taken to hospital in Dax in a serious condition.

The ARS, or back-to-school allowance will be paid out tomorrow and Wednesday to help more than three million households buy school supplies. More families than ever are believed to be waiting for the payment due to the rise in the cost of living. The sum paid out for the ARS itself has seen a 5.6% increase this year.
