Two young people have been arrested after the death of a head teacher in the grounds of the college where he taught. The 17-year-old and 19-year-old have admitted to entering the establishment by breaking down a door, but they claim that they left the premises before the headteacher arrived. The analysis of one of their telephones seems to support this statement. The cause of death of the victim is still not known. Stéphane Vitel went to the college after the burglar alarm went off. He was found dead minutes later by his family.

Two bodies have been found in Lavau sur Loire in the Loire Atlantique, in the same area where a plane carrying three people crashed yesterday. Onboard were the journalist Gérard Leclerc and the daughter of the former head of the Senate René Monory. The two bodies have not yet been identified. The aircraft had left Loudun in Vienne and was due to land at La Baule.

This summer's heatwave continues with two new départements placed on amber weather alert for extreme heat tomorrow, the Loire and the Haute Loire.
