The school year has begun for more than 12 million students who returned to class this morning. This new school year is marked in particular by the ban on the abaya - The traditional dress worn by Muslim women. Elisabeth Borne was this morning in a school in Saint-Germain-sur-île in Ile et Vilaine to welcome the students and no incidents were noted according to the Prime Minister.

Elisabeth Borne was traveling with the Minister of Education, Gabriel Attal, who announced an upcoming experiment on wearing uniforms at school. The modalities will be detailed in the fall.
