The summer of 2023 has broken all records. It is the hottest ever recorded according to the European Copernicus Observatory, with 16.77 degrees on average with absolute records in many regions of the world: more than 50 degrees in Mexico and in the Death Valley in California and more than 45 degrees in Rome and Naples.

The year 2023 is also expected to be by far the hottest year on record. Extreme temperatures are even expected to persist for the next 5 years.

An investigation is open following the suicide of a 15-year-old boy, who hanged himself last night in his room in Poissy in Yvelines. The teenager had reported incidents of school harassment last year. He had changed establishments and returned to school on Monday at a vocational high school in the 14th arrondissement of Paris.
