The XV de France is launching its home World Cup this evening with a shock match against New Zealand. Les Bleus are said to have prepared this event with a lot of serenity.

This France - New Zealand match kicks off at 9:15 p.m. at the Stade de France. The opening ceremony will be hosted by the actor Jean Dujardin and a twenty-minute show will take place with Vianney and Zaz among others.

Abroad, Russia stops the Ukrainian counter-offensive thanks to its air superiority, according to a statement made by Volodymyr Zelensky. The Ukrainian President has asked the West to accelerate military aid for Kiev and to strengthen sanctions against Moscow.

And then it will still be very hot tomorrow. An orange heat wave alert will be maintained in the 14 departments concerned today. The alert extends from the Ile de France to the center of the Loire Valley. Temperatures could reach 36 degrees this weekend and are not expected to drop before Monday.
