Gérald Darmanin is traveling to Corsica. The Minister of the Interior is expected this afternoon on the island for a 2-day visit. The institutional future of the local authority will be discussed, as Corsican elected officials are unable to agree on project of autonomy.

Corsica libera requests the revision of the protocol of understanding signed last year between the Minister of the Interior and the President of the Executive Council of Corsica - A protocol which maintains Corsica in the Republic with the refusal to create two categories of citizens.

In the rest of the news, 1 person has died, and 7 others are in intensive care at the Bordeaux hospital after contracting botulism by going to the same restaurant: The Tchín Tchín Wine Bar. Foods in cause are thought to be canned sardines, according to the Regional Health Agency.

And in Morocco, the hope of finding survivors is fading away 5 days after the terrible earthquake which ravaged the country. The disaster has caused the death of 2,900 people. King Mohammed VI visited victims last night in a hospital of Marrakech.

And then no more national anthems sung in canon at the Rugby World Cup. The organizers revised their copy after numerous criticisms. From now on, each federation will have the choice between an anthem performed by children and another more classic version.
