For the first time in France, the parents of a teenage girl who was harassed at school and who committed suicide two years ago are filing a complaint against TikTok. They denounce provocation to suicide and propaganda of means to kill oneself on behalf of the social network. A few weeks before ending her life, their 15-year-old daughter had published a video on TikTok to discuss her problems. The post had provoked the publication on her account of other videos of the same type.

In Dunkirk, an investigation into intentional homicide has been opened after a man was killed in his house last night. He was woken up by burglars as he was sleeping in his room. The fifty-year-old man was fatally injured by several stab wounds. His wife managed to escape with their child before calling the police.

Also in the news, the government's objective is to do everything possible to lower prices at the pump. To achieve this, Bruno Lemaire mentioned the possibility for distributors to sell fuel at a loss. A measure that will be effective by the beginning of December for a period of six months according to the Minister of the Economy. A bill on this subject will be presented in October to the National Assembly.

And they will once again make their anger heard. Liberal doctors' unions are calling for a new strike from October 13. And the movement could be unlimited. This mobilization is to demand an increase in the price of consultations to reach 30 or 50 euros depending on the specialties. The negotiations carried out last winter with the *Assurance Maladie* had failed, giving rise to a revaluation of 1 euro and 50 cents. This was insufficient for the unions of the profession which demand the immediate resumption of discussions.

Finally, only 2 departments are placed this evening under orange alert for rainstorms and floods: Ardèche and Drôme. In these two departments, firefighters have intervened more than 100 times today. And as a consequence of this bad weather, the A7 highway is closed in the south-north direction between Valence in Drôme and Chanas. In Isère, 200 mm of water fell in two hours this morning.
