The representatives of the main distribution brands are gathered since this morning in Bercy. Bruno Lemaire summoned them to discuss the government approach of selling fuel at a loss to lower prices at the pump. The measure will supposedly be effective from December 1 for a period of 6 months. However, this is not necessarily a solution for Céline Antonin, economist at the OFCE, who recommends an arbitration between ecological and economic issues.

The text of law on the authorization of sale at a loss will be examined in October at the National Assembly.
