A 14-year-old teenager was arrested in his classroom yesterday in a middle school of Alfortville in Val-de-Marne. He is suspected of having harassed a high school girl on Instagram. The boy is said to have held homophobic remarks and incited suicide by harassing a student from another establishment in the city who is in the middle of a gender transition. It was her family who warned the principal before filing a complaint.

It is in this context that Gabriel Attal calls for an electric shock at all levels in the face of school harassment. After receiving the rectors yesterday, the Minister of Education launched an audit in all academies after the suicide of a 15-year-old teenager in Poissy. The Versailles rectorate did not take seriously the reports of the victim's parents.

And the searches were not successful. A new operation took place this morning in the Haut Vernet in the Alpes-de-Haute-Provence to try to find clues about the disappearance of little Emile - The 2-and-a-half-year-old boy who disappeared since July 8. A team of gendarmerie divers inspected a lake of more than 1,000 square meters but did not find anything.

Regarding the cases of Botulism in Bordeaux, relatives of the 32-year-old woman who died after consuming home-made canned sardines in a bar in the city have filed a complaint against the restaurant owner for involuntary manslaughter. The Bordeaux public prosecutor's office has already opened a preliminary investigation for the same charge and for unintentional injuries. In total, around 15 people were contaminated.
