The rectorate of Versailles is once called out to account for its actions. In a letter, a father was threatened by the academy after having filed a complaint for the molestation of his daughter at school. The rectorate was already accused after the revelation of a problematic letter addressed to the parents of a teenager who has since committed suicide. In a press release, the Minister of National Education Gabriel Attal firmly condemns the terms used in these letters.

Marine Le Pen could be referred to justice. In any case, the Paris prosecutor's office is calling for a trial of the former presidential candidate indicted in the case of the Front National parliamentary assistants - A case which may be judged by the criminal court for embezzlement of public funds and complicity. The prosecution is also requesting a trial for the mayor of Perpignan Louis Aliot and the former right-hand man of the party Bruno Gollnisch. They are suspected of having participated in a system of embezzlement of European public funds between 2004 and 2016.

The visit of the Pope is being prepared. The sovereign pontiff will arrive this afternoon in Marseille. He will be welcomed at the airport by Elisabeth Borne before paying tribute to the sailors and migrants lost at sea, at Notre Dame de la Garde. The Pope will also parade tomorrow on Avenue du Prado, before giving a High Mass at the Stade Vélodrome.

And Charles III and his wife Camilla are expected in Bordeaux for the last day of their trip to France. They will meet with Mayor Pierre Hurmic, visit an experimental forest and tour an organic wine estate.

To finish: French employees of Apple Stores are on strike today and tomorrow, just as the new Iphone is being released. They are demanding salary increases. A demonstration is also planned at Place de l'Opéra in Paris.
