Elisabeth Borne will be bringing together the relevant groups this week to address Emmanuel Macron's pledge to ask distributors to set a fixed cost price on fuel. The President made the announcement to channels TF1 and France 2. Macron also announced that a fuel allowance will be offered to the most modest households, with a maximum of 100 euros per car per year.

Emmanuel Macron will be presenting the government's latest plan for the environment today, a set of measures aimed at reducing the country's greenhouse gas emissions by 138 million tonnes by 2030. The first announcements came last night and include the end of the last two French coal-fired power stations which will both be converted to biomass fuels.

The trial on the Magnanville attack opens today. On June 13, 2016, a police officer and his partner were murdered at their home, in Yvelines, in front of their 3-year-old son. The terrorist, Larossi Abballa, was killed during the attack. One of his friends, Mohamed Lamine Aberouz, is now on trial for aiding and abetting in terrorist assassinations. He faces a life sentence.

And finally to the Rugby World Cup, Wales has taken the world by storm to become the first team to qualify for the quarter finals. The shock result in Pool C comes after Wales' stunning victory against Australia last night in Lyon, with a final score of 40-6.
